

**Scenario:** You find an infant that is unresponsive. As you approach you determine your scene is safe and you start to approach the victim. Show me what you would do.

**Initial Scene Management**

- Check for breathing, responsiveness, and a pulse for no more than 10 seconds
- Calls for help, directs someone to call 911 and get an AED

Instructor informs the candidate that the victim is not breathing, not responding, but does have a strong pulse.

**Identifies Opioid Overdose**

- Checks patient's pupils

**Rescue Breathing**

- Provides one rescue breath every six seconds
  - Ensures chest rise
  - Stops on chest rise

**Naloxone Administration**

- Safely and appropriately administers Naloxone

Each student must perform all steps, but may be spread across multiple scenarios.
