Scenario: You find an infant that is unresponsive. As you approach you determine your scene is safe and you start to approach the victim. Show me what you would do.

Initial Scene Management
☐ Check for breathing, responsiveness, and a pulse for no more than 10 seconds☐ Calls for help, directs someone to call 911 and get an AED
Instructor informs the candidate that the victim is not breathing, not responding, but does have a strong pulse.
Identifies Opioid Overdose
☐ Checks patient's pupils
Rescue Breathing
☐ Provides one rescue breath every six seconds
☐ Ensures chest rise
☐ Stops on chest rise
Naloxone Administration
☐ Safely and appropriately administers Naloxone

Each student must perform all steps, but may be spread across multiple scenarios.
